

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased from Department of Commerce, Babarmahal, Kathmandu by eligible Bidders on the submission of a written application, along with the copy of company/firm registration certificate, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1000.00 till **Magh 11, 2074 during office hours**.
4. Sealed bids must be submitted to **Department of Commerce, Babarmahal, Kathmandu** by *hand* on or before **12:00 hrs on Magh 12, 2074**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
5. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at **[14:00 hrs on Magh12, 2074]** at the **Department of Commerce, Babarmahal, Kathmandu** .Bids must be valid for a period of 45 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to a minimum of **NPR 34,000.00** which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid (i.e. **Chaitra 28,2074**).
6. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
